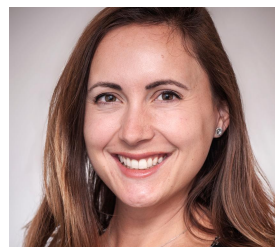
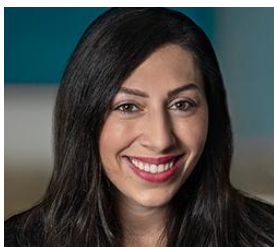
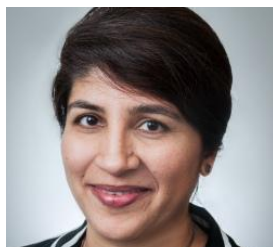
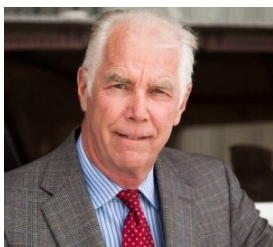


# Juvenile Myositis Family Educational Conference
